After speaking with Cindy at Anglers Pro Shop anglersproshop@hotmail.com I will try to explain how this cards works and hope that this makes sense.

The Outdoors Card is valid for 3 years. This card will allow you to purchase fishing

licenses in the future at the shop or online in Ontario. It is not a valid fishing license without the paper tag.

Cindy was saying that it will work like your drivers license in the states when you are wanting to buy a license.

You will not have to renew the Outdoors card for 3 years and you should have an expiry date on the front of the

card.
